

UNIFORM POLICY

All scholars come to school in their Osborne uniform every day. Uniforms allow us to build community by creating a common image of the Osborne scholar and limit classroom distractions. Our uniform policy also reinforces our schools' culture of high expectations and academic achievement.

Students are expected to wear a uniform every day Monday-Friday. Once a student walks on to the school grounds or school bus, their uniform shirt must be tucked in, a belt should be on (as appropriate), pants should be pulled up, and they should be wearing the appropriate uniform clothing and shoes.

Uniform for the 2026 - 2027 School Year

- A CCS Mildred Osborne polo shirt (Pre K-1-2: yellow/ 3-4-5: green/ 6-7-8: navy)
- A CCS Mildred Osborne spirit shirt (Principal's Honor List, Perfect Attendance, Pre-K/K promotion shirt, Homecoming Shirt, etc)
- Pants are to be khaki-colored dress, non-denim, uniform type slacks. Pants are to be the appropriate size for the students, must fit properly at the waist and may be neither too tight nor too baggy. Bell-bottom, cargo, corduroy, patch-pocketed, joggers, sweatpant, or jean type pants are not allowed as part of the uniform. Pants are to be hemmed (shoe-top length) and have no frayed edges or cut bottoms. Uniform shorts and skorts must be knee length.
- A plain black belt (no slogans, writing, characters or large buckles) (1st -8th grade)
- Any color shoes with an athletic/ non marking sole (1st -8th grade)
- **Any color velcro shoes with an athletic/ non marking sole (Pre K, KDG)**
- The only clothing worn over the uniform must be the school's sweatshirt, jacket, or cardigan
- Name badge on left collar
- Black, white, or gray undershirt (long or short sleeve)
- Students can wear any color of socks or tights (must be worn daily)
- No make-up/false lashes.
- No bonnets or sleep scarves.
- Nails need to be appropriate length to complete all school enrichment activities.
- **Clear or mesh backpack**

Uniform Sales

Osborne uniform items can be purchased at the front office. Uniform shirts, and sweatshirts are \$20 and cardigans are \$40. Cash, credit cards and money orders can be accepted for payment. Checks are **NOT** accepted.

Consequences for uniform violations:
